



Viticultural Appellation

The vineyards making up the Elliot Burt Cabernet Sauvignon are located on the eastern slopes of the Kelseyville Bench. This area is renowned for its similarity to the Napa Valley being just 20-25 miles north as the crow flies. Here, the rocky soils and exceptional drainage produces a lively wine capable of years in the bottle. Fermented in stainless steel and racked into French Oak post ML, the wine aged for 16 months prior to being racked out of barrel and bottled.

Tasting Notes

As the crow flies, the Lake County vineyards that produced this wine are a short 20-25 miles north of the Napa Valley. Sourced from bench land nestled against the mountains, the soil is well drained and produces intense fruit. The wine displays layers of ripe currant, plum and French Oak. With a little time in the glass, it expands showing hints of chocolate and blackberry followed by a long finish.
