



OAKVILLE EAST - CORE STONE 2017 – RED WINE

- CONSISTENTLY RATED IN THE MID 90'S BY WINE WRITERS BECAUSE WHEN YOUNG THE CABERNET FRANC FILLS IN THE MIDDLE PALATE WITH HUGE FLAVORS AND AROMAS.
- SOFT ELEGANT TANNINS ALLOW FOR YOUNG CONSUMPTION; NEVERTHELESS, THE WINE WILL LAST EASILY FOR 15 YEARS.
- A GREAT BORDEAUX STYLED WINE WITH SUPPORTING HUGE FRUIT WITH STRUCTURED WOOD INFLUENCE WHICH DOES NOT OVERPOWER THE WINE.
- NAMED AFTER THE EXPOSED CORE STONES FROM A COLLAPSED VACA MOUNTAIN.

This "Right Bank" styled blend of Cabernet Sauvignon (68%), Cabernet Franc (30%) and Petit Verdot (2%) from our Oakville East Vineyards brings forward aromas of blueberry, blackberry, tobacco, vanilla, marshmallow, black currant, tea, roses, violets, dust and a hint of mint. The mid palate is full bodied with fine velvet chewy tannins with bright balanced acidity, with flavors of rhubarb, cocoa, strawberry, cassis, and plum.
