

Viticultural Appellation

The top of the mountain overlooking Oakville in the Napa Valley is truly a unique appellation. Above the fog line and enjoying an additional 2 hours of light after sunset has darkened the valley, the fruit enjoyed a substantially longer hang time and much smaller berry size due to the extreme conditions. The result is a concentration of flavor and color typical of one of the most famous AVA's in the Napa Valley. Great care is taken to treat this fruit with kid gloves making every effort to allow this very small segment of an even smaller AVA truly express its full potential. Oakville is one of the Napa Valleys exceptional growing regions for Cabernet Sauvignon.

Tasting Notes

The 2020 Spokesman Oakville Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from vineyards high above the valley floor on the east side of the Napa Valley. These mountains are volcanic and contain large amounts of iron rich red soil resulting in bright expansive fruit, amazing mouth feel and lingering finish. Harvested at 24.3 prix, the wine was hand sorted and crushed straight to Stainless steel for a 4 day cold soak. During this time, the fruit was allowed to contribute the maximum complexity and color possible prior to kicking off fermentation. Aged is only French Oak, the wine has layers of black currant, cherry and hints of cedar, sweet oak and baking spices on the finish. Spokesman is a perfect companion to relaxed evenings with good friends, aged red meats, stinky cheeses and a variety of pasta.
